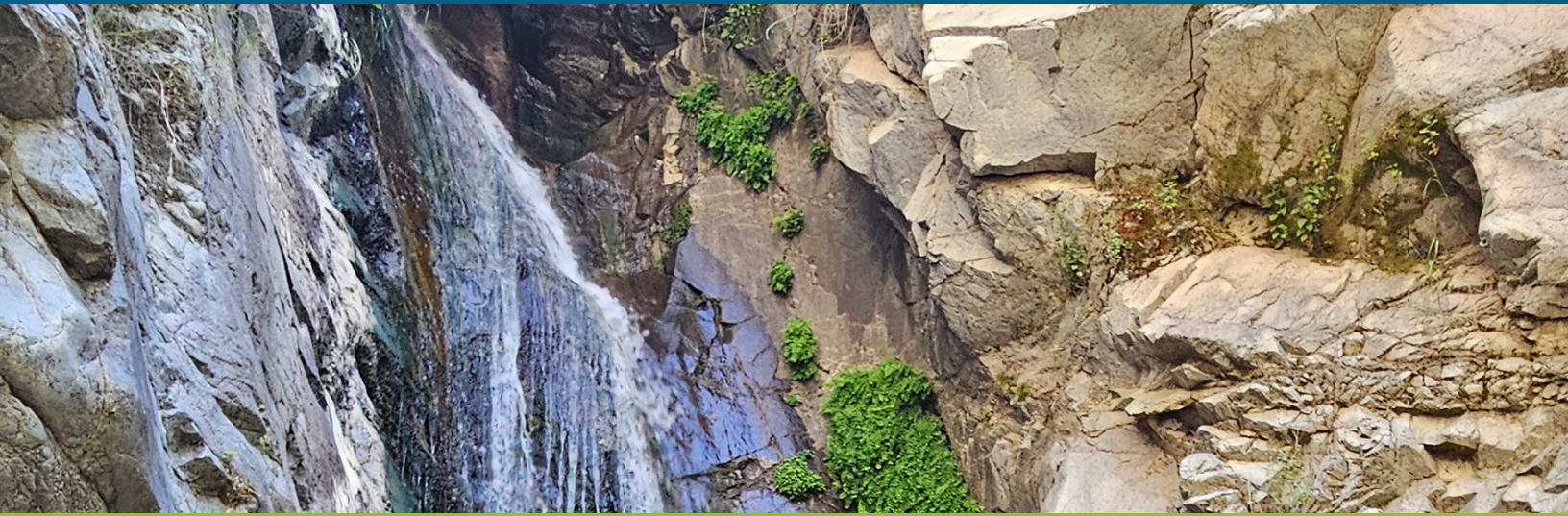

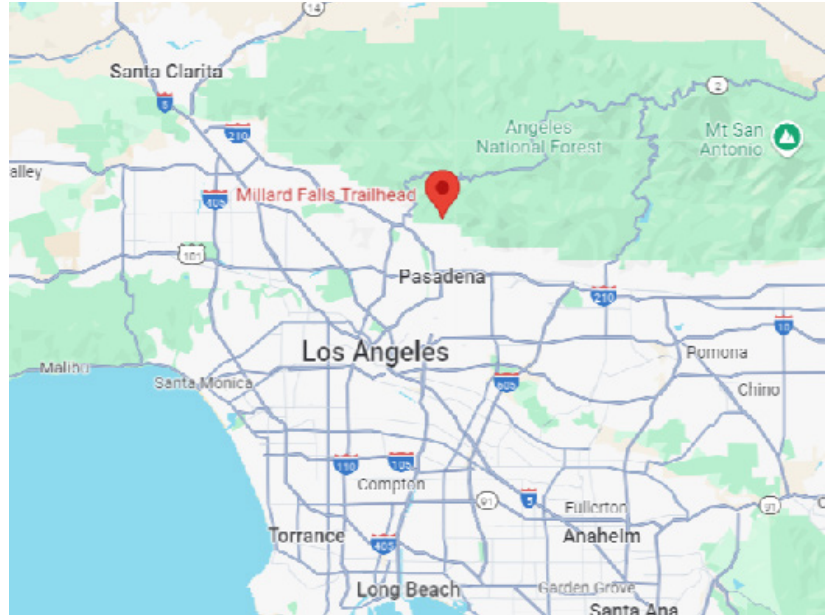

DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION AND ACTIVITIES:

This hike, situated in the scenic San Gabriel Mountains of Southern California, covers a moderate 1.5 mile hike out and back and provides a perfect blend of challenge and reward. The trail leading to the falls has been maintained and managed by the U.S. Forest Service, ensuring that visitors can enjoy the beauty of the area while preserving its natural state.

The journey begins at a well-marked trailhead, where you'll find yourself surrounded by the lush greenery of the canyon. This is where we checked in with participants. As you follow the trail, which is often shaded by towering trees, you'll traverse through varied terrain, including rocky paths, crossing the riverbed, and gentle slopes. The trail is well-maintained, but be prepared for some steep sections that may require careful footing. The real highlight, however, is the waterfall at the trail's end. Millard Canyon Falls cascades down a rocky cliff, creating a serene and picturesque backdrop. Once the participants reached the falls, they were given time to eat snacks and enjoy the view. The trail can get busy on weekends, so starting early or visiting during weekdays might give you a more peaceful experience.

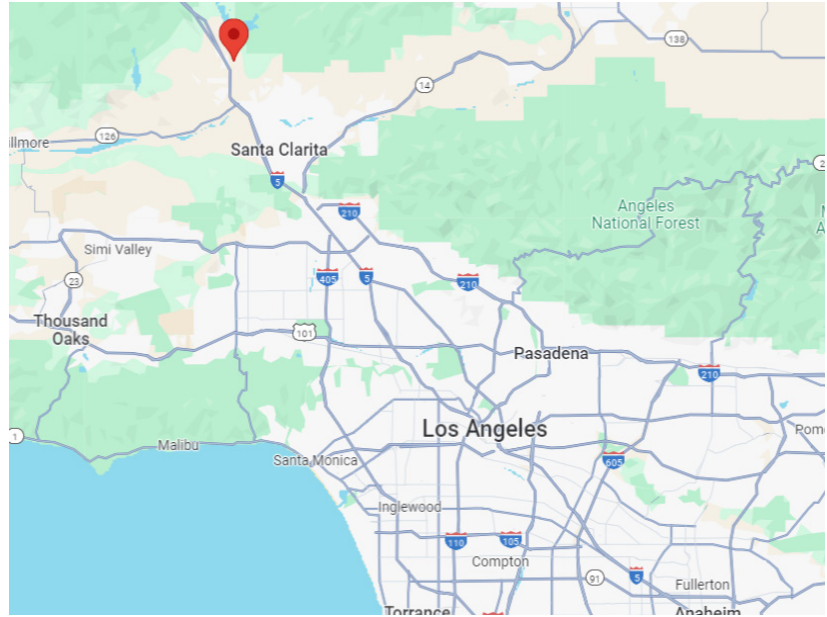

DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION AND ACTIVITIES:

Castaic Lagoon is a serene and expansive waterway known for its crystal-clear waters and scenic surroundings. Ideal for water sports enthusiasts and nature lovers alike, the lagoon provides a peaceful retreat with stunning views of the surrounding hills and lush landscapes. The area around Castaic Lagoon was initially part of agricultural lands and natural landscapes. The lagoon itself is part of the larger Castaic Lake State Recreation Area, which was originally established to serve as a water reservoir. Its primary purpose was to capture and store water for agricultural and municipal use.

Participants were invited to participate in either kayaking or paddleboarding with Cruise Castaic Rentals. The day started with two shuttles picking up participants at the Jeff Seymour Family Center. They were then taken to either the launch pad or the swim beach to start their day. If they were taken to the launch pad, participants were provided with instructors for the first 30 minutes before they could independently move throughout the lake. If they were taken to the swim beach, they were given time for beach swimming and relaxing. Both groups would then switch activities in the later in the day.
